ORDER GRANTING EMERGENCY INJUNCTION

AND NOW this day of March 2015, upon consideration of the allegations of the verified complaint filed in this action and the Plaintiff's Petition for Emergency Injunction and having determined that:

- 1. Plaintiff will suffer irreparable harm and loss if Defendants are permitted to disclose information regarding Judge Grine's telephone communications;
 - 2. Plaintiff has no adequate remedy at law;
 - 3. Plaintiff has a clear right to relief;
- 4. Emergency injunctive relief is appropriate and necessary to prevent immediate and irreparable injury;
- 5. Greater injury will be inflicted upon Plaintiff by the denial of temporary injunctive relief than would be inflicted upon Defendants by the granting of such relief;

- 6. The requested relief will maintain the status quo ante pending trial on the merits; and,
- 7. The requested relief is reasonable related to abating the risk of harm to Plaintiff.

 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND DECREED THAT:
- (1) Defendant County of Centre, The McShane Firm, LLC and Theodore C. Tanski ("Defendants") are hereby ENJOINED from disclosing, in any manner, any information related to Judge Grine's telephone communications;
 - (2) The injunction shall be effective immediately;
- (3) Plaintiff shall deposit security of \$500 with the Court within 24 hours or this injunction shall have no further force or effect; and
- (4) A hearing on Plaintiff's Petition for Preliminary Injunction shall be held on Monday, March 23, 2015, at 9 A.M./P.M. in the 3rd Floor Annex.
